- Communities in Bloom – Gwen Jonner
 - ♦ *Communities in Bloom was started in 2005, a Canadian beautification program that provides information and recognition by awarding “Bloom ratings” to the participating communities.*
- Bell Barn Tour – Jerry Willerth
 - ♦ *The Bell Barn Society was formed in 2006 specifically to ensure that the historic Bell Barn, in imminent danger of total collapse, would be saved. The Bell Barn was rebuilt to its original design and reopened in 2010.*
- Why Save Seeds – Ruth Ann Rudack
 - ♦ *This will be a very basic talk on why it is important to save seeds, and basic seed saving techniques for the simplest plants, with an emphasis on vegetables, and easy annual flowers.*
- Beyond Basics – David Gehl
 - ♦ *This talk will be about advanced seed saving, with an emphasis on his passion, heirloom tomatoes, but also about isolation distances, bagging seed heads, etc.*
